

# Comanche Nation Youth Services Sponsorship Application Policies & Procedures

- 1. All applicants must be enrolled members of the Comanche Nation and provide a copy of their **CDIB** (Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood).
- 2. Assistance will be provided to Comanche-enrolled youth enrolled in **Pre-K through 12th grade**.
- 3. Applicants must provide a copy of the flyer or brochure containing the fees and vendor/camp information.
- 4. The allowance for youth will be granted once per year, up to ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00), to be used toward a camp, clinic, or event in their respective sport or recreational activity of choice.
- 5. Checks will be made payable directly to the organization conducting the camp or event—NOT to the participant or parent/guardian. W9 required from Vendor. Reimbursements will NOT be allowed.
- 6. COMPLETED APPLICATIONS must be submitted to the Comanche Nation Youth Services office at least two weeks before the deadline of the selected camp or clinic. Incomplete applications will not be processed. Applicants are responsible for submitting all required documents.
- 7. Participants/applicants will be responsible for any **remaining fees, meals, transportation, supplies, etc.,** associated with the camp, clinic, or event.
- 8. Participants are responsible for registering and submitting any required documents directly to the chosen event. The Comanche Nation Youth Services will only process payment if the application is approved. It is the applicant's responsibility to confirm approval before registering.
- 9. Participants and their parent/guardian must sign and abide by the Comanche Nation Youth Services "Sportsmanship and Parent Code of Conduct" and must conduct themselves accordingly throughout the camp, clinic, or event.
- 10. Participation in the chosen activity may include a risk of injury. By applying, the participant releases the Comanche Nation Youth Services, its employees, and the Comanche Nation from any responsibility for accidents or injuries that may occur while participating in the camp, clinic, or event.
