I. INTRODUCTION

The Comanche Nation, located in Lawton, Oklahoma, is seeking proposals from qualified architectural and engineering (A/E) firms to provide design services for the **Tribal Complex Expansion – Strategic Master Plan**.

Expansion - Strategic Master Plan.

III. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE

The Comanche Nation (CN) seeks a qualified A/E firm to provide professional design services for the strategic master planning, architectural design, and engineering of its governmental complex.

Key Objectives:

- Feasibility study: expansion vs. relocation
- Topographic, ALTA, and utility surveys
- Soil testing on fee and trust lands
- Recommendations for community-centered amenities, including:
 - Administrative office space
 - Community center with indoor pool
 - Expanded multipurpose building
 - Road upgrades, cafeteria, and gift shop
 - Recreational paths and veteran monuments
- Conceptual drawings and renderings
- Phased development plan with cost estimates
- Compliance with Comanche Nation law and jurisdiction
- Use of AIA A133 and A201 contract formats

Preference will be given to Native-owned firms (minimum 51% ownership) with proof of enrollment (CDIB or equivalent).

IV. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Comanche Nation is a federally recognized tribe headquartered in Lawton, Oklahoma. The selected firm will evaluate options for expanding or relocating the governmental complex and develop a comprehensive strategic master plan.

Responsibilities Include:

- Evaluate expansion vs. relocation
- Conduct feasibility studies and site surveys
- Deliver phased development plans, renderings, and cost estimates
- Incorporate cultural design elements
- Coordinate with Direct 2 Completion, LLC (D2C), serving as the Owner's Representative

V. BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVES

The existing tribal complex is located approximately eight miles north of Lawton on I-44. Limited infrastructure has forced several programs into leased facilities across the city. This project aims to assess and plan for a sustainable, culturally reflective, long-term facility solution.

VI. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES

The selected firm shall provide a complete **Strategic Master Plan**, including:

A. Needs Assessment & Feasibility Study

- Evaluate current and future facility needs (~40,000 sq. ft.)
- Assess existing vs. new site options
- Provide land-use and infrastructure recommendations

B. Site & Land Analysis

- Conduct topographic, utility, and soil surveys
- Provide AutoCAD-compatible files

C. Facility & Amenities Planning

- Evaluate traffic, stormwater, utilities, and environmental factors
- · Assess fire protection, sewer, water, and telecom capacity

D. Conceptual & Architectural Design

- Produce concept drawings and architectural renderings
- Incorporate cultural and sustainable design principles

E. Phased Implementation Plan

- Define development phases and associated costs
- Identify funding strategies and potential risks

F. Final Master Plan Document

- Submit final report by March 31, 2026
- Present findings to the Comanche General Council (April 2026)
