

PROGRAM SUMMARY

New Pathways is the only Native American Halfway House in the Southwest Indian Health Service region.

New Pathways is a 90-day, non-medical, transitional living facility for Native Americans who have completed an inpatient Primary Residential Treatment and still require a moderately structured living environment.

New Pathways is the intermediate step between residential treatment and independent living. Individuals practice improved living skills acquired in residential treatment, while receiving positive feedback and emotional support from fellow residents and alcoholism treatment specialists.

The service area includes, but is not limited to, Caddo, Comanche, Cotton, Kiowa and Tillman Counties in Southwest Oklahoma.

Preference is given to Comanche Tribal members, then to member of all tribes of Oklahoma.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 18 years or older
- Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood
- Completion certificate from primary residential Treatment
- Must be willing to commit to inpatient residential supervision for 90 days not to exceed 120 days
- Must be willing and physically able to work
- Must be willing to participate in all aspects of his/her recovery
- Must be motivated to become self-sufficient

PROGRAM SERVICES

- In-patient residential supervision
- Immediate Shelter (door-to-door)
- Meals provided daily
- Substance-abuse education
- Individual counseling
- Advocacy and referrals
- Employment resources
- Limited van transportation
- Random drug/breathalyzer testing
- Daily morning meditation
- Alcoholics Anonymous® meetings
- Wellbriety® talking circles
- Native American Swear Lodge
